Grateful for the honors program, good class sizes and attentive administration.

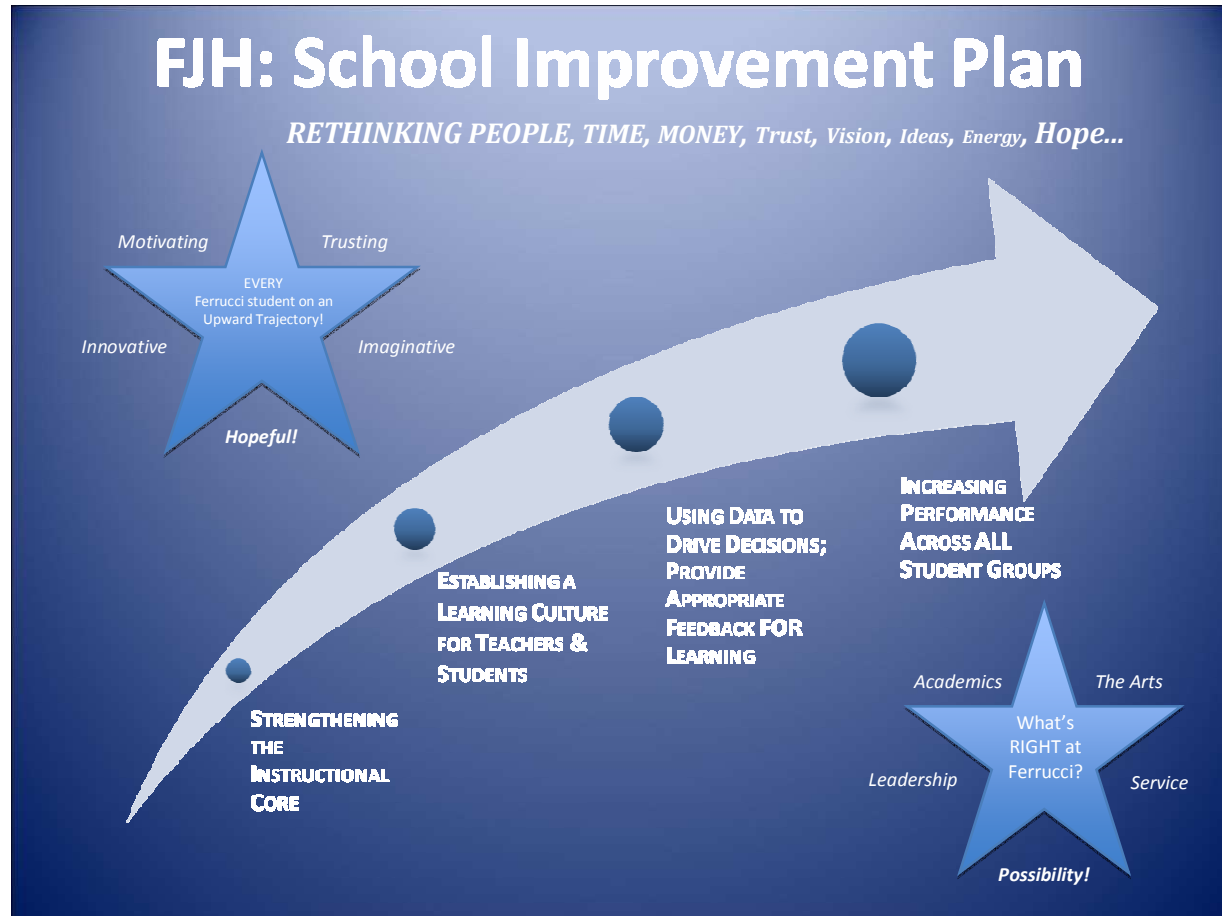
